Copyright

Legal right of the owner of intellectual property for his or her original work.

Fair Use

Section 107 of the Copyright Law

The reproduction of a particular work may be considered fair, such as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, and research.

Factors to determine the fair use are:

1. The purpose and character of the use (Commercial or non-profit educational)
2. The nature of the copyrighted work
3. The amount and substantiality of the portion used.
4. The effect of the use upon the potential market for, or value of, the copyrighted work
